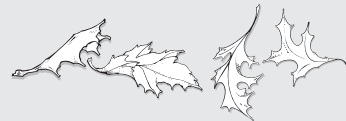

— Officers & Board of Directors Message —

As your Officers and Board of Directors, we believe it is our duty and of the utmost importance to share with you a summary of where the Association stands financially. We are very proud of what we have accomplished in the eight months we have been in office and hope that you feel the same way!

In summary, the Club has generated net profits of \$26.1k on total sales of \$122.7k through the first seven months of 2018. This compares very favorably to a net loss of \$8.2k on total sales of \$97.1k for the seven months ending 7/31/17. These positive results are mostly due to more events at the Club which have driven stronger food and bar sales, coupled with much tighter expense control with kitchen and bar purchase and also payroll expense.

We would also like to provide an update on the Bravo Fest results. We are happy to announce the event produced profits of \$20k on total sales of \$38.4k. The Bravo committee was successful in securing booklet donations totaling \$20.8k which alone covered the Fest expenses of \$17k. Other contributing factors include bringing the event back to the Arena which allowed for lower overhead and increased attendance, stronger marketing efforts, and also bringing in local restaurants which reduced food cost. While we consider the event a success, we also realize there is room for improvement and it is our promise to make next year's Fest even better!

The future looks bright for our Club, and with continuous hard work and member participation, there is no doubt the Club's doors will stay open and it will continue to prosper with its members.
